The self-understanding skills of the students will be measured through the class "The Helping Relationship," Final research paper and presentation.

The criterion for success is that 80% of the students will score 80% or better.

### \_GEAA 2\_ b. Description of Data Collection & Assessment Results:

The Helping Relationship was taught in the Spring 2008 and Spring 2009. The results were that 87% of the students scored 80% or better (33 out of the 38 students scored 80% or better). Goal was met.

## Second Means of Assessment for Outcome Identified Above:

The self-understanding skills of the student will be measured through the class "Creativity and Innovation" with the completion of an individual creative project

that includes creating something that has form and substance and writing a paper describing the principles and modes for creativity that were used in the process.

The criterion for success is that 80% of the students will score 80% or better on use of techniques section of paper.

\_GEAA 2\_b. Description of Data Collection & Assessment Results:

This class was taught in the Fall of 2008. Results were that 89% of students scored 80% or better (15 out of 17 students). Goal was met.

Continued emphasis on self-understanding skills.

The self-understanding skills of the student will be measured through the class “Foundations of Psychology” through participation in panel discussions in class.
